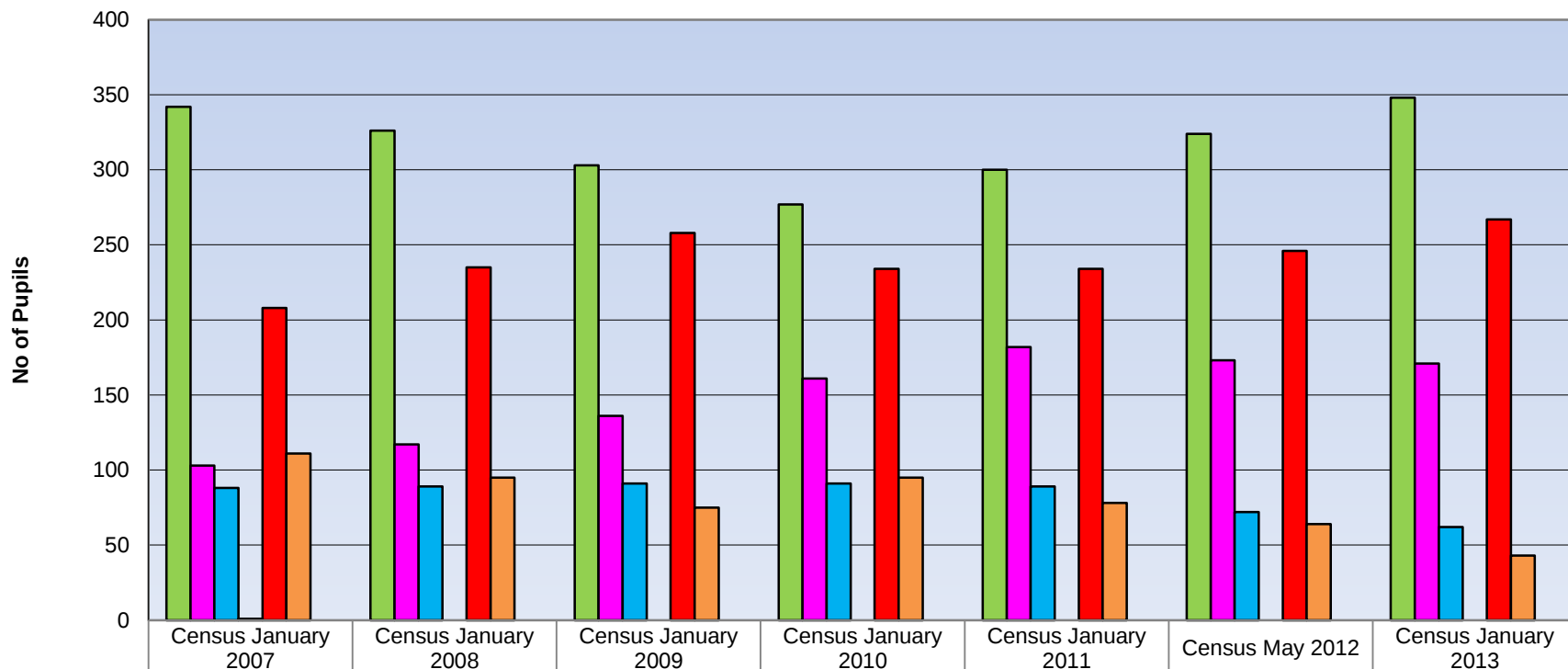

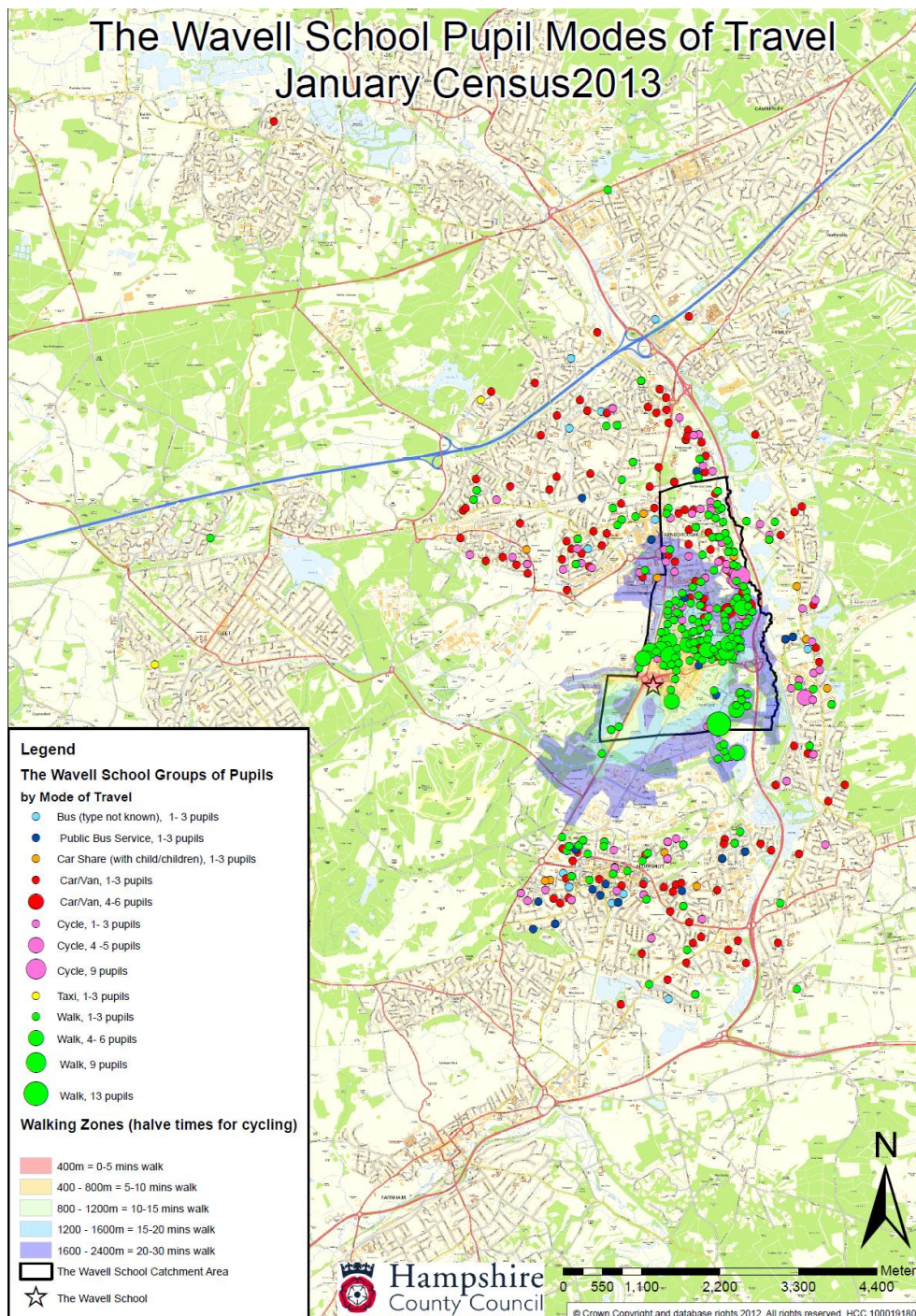

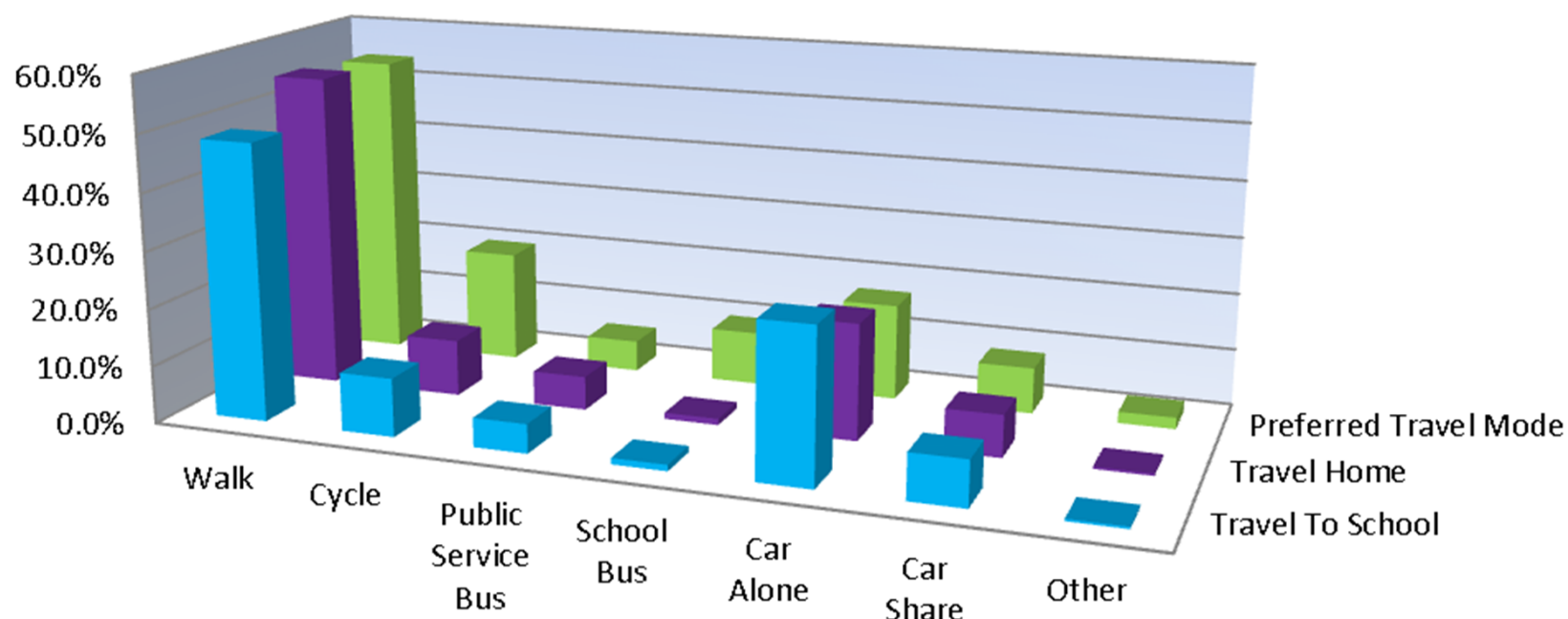
- 800m = 0-5 mins cycle
- 800 - 1600m = 5-10 mins cycle
- 1600 - 2400m = 10-15 mins cycle

- 3200 - 4800m = 20-30 mins cycle

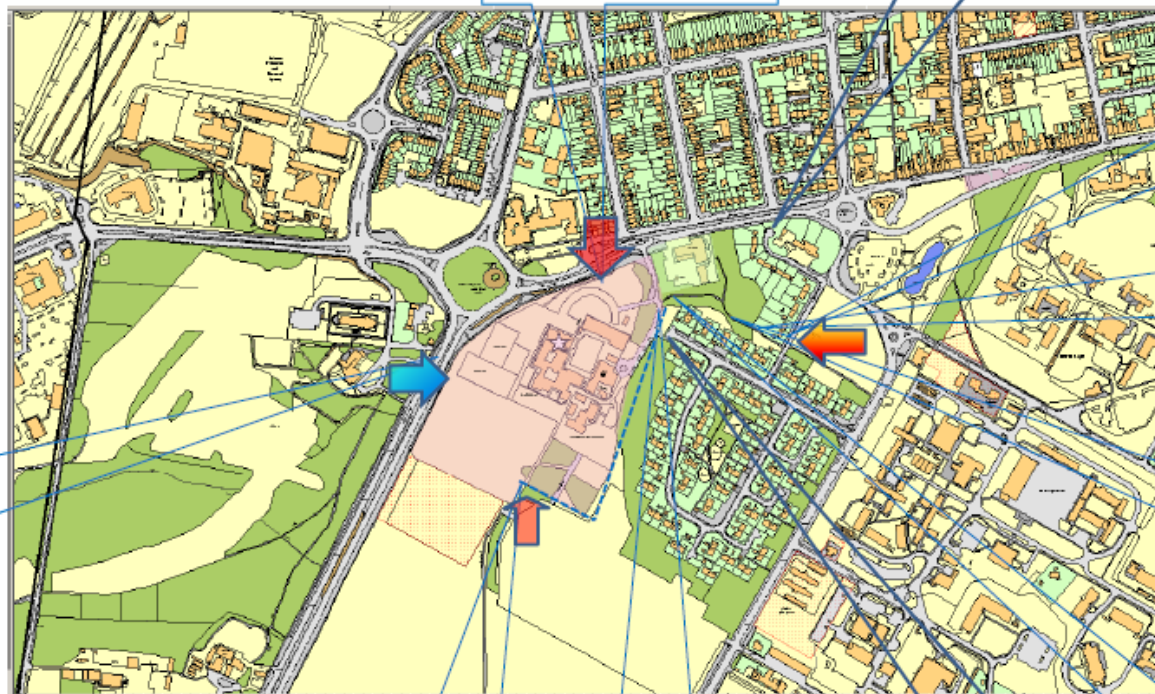

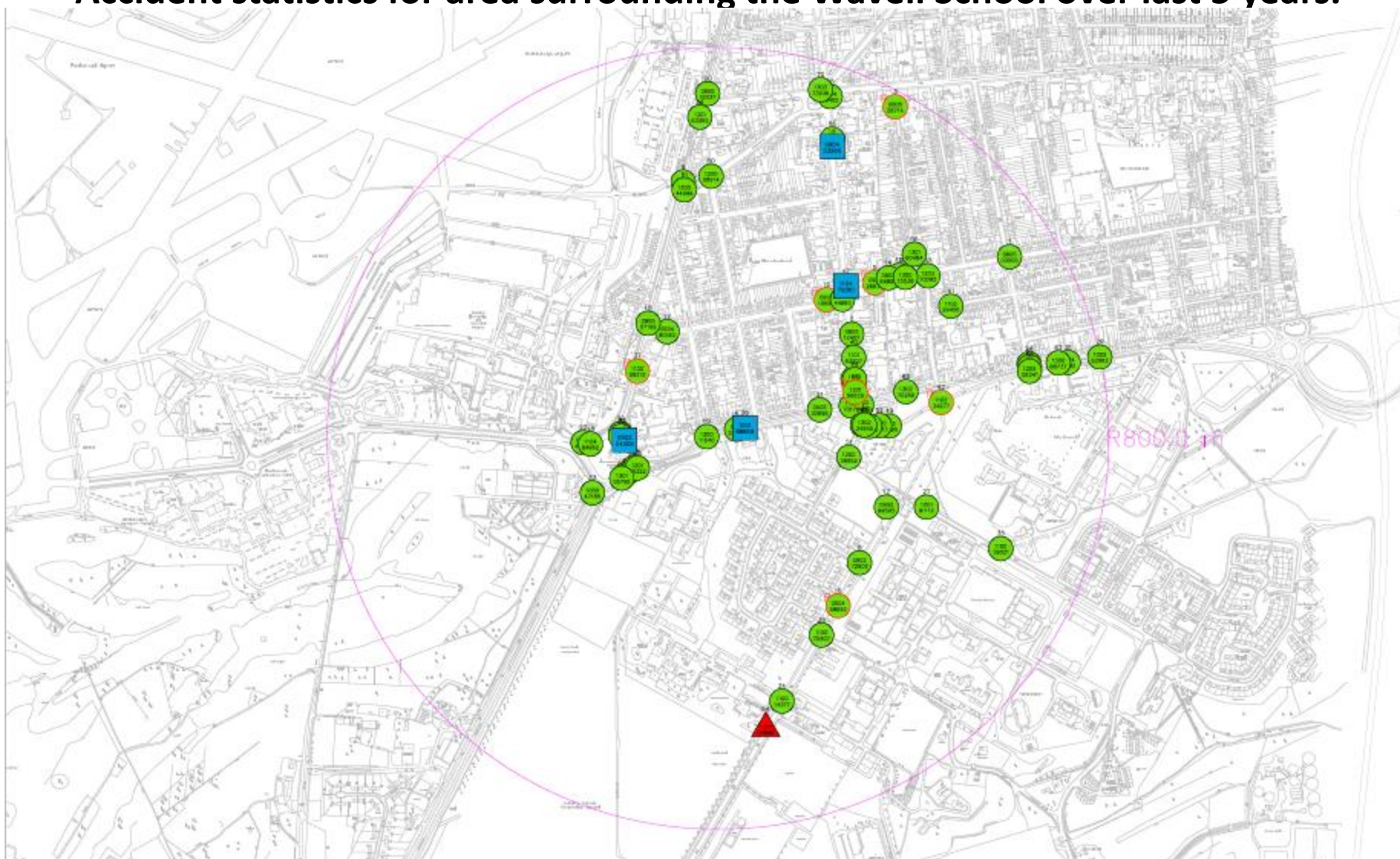

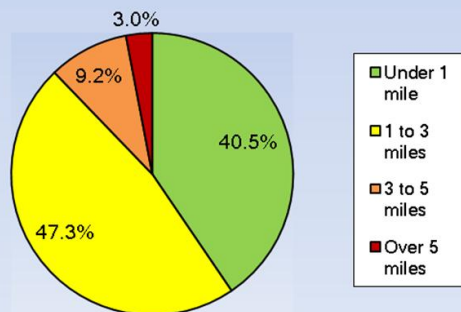

Accident statistics for area surrounding the Wavell School over last 5 years.

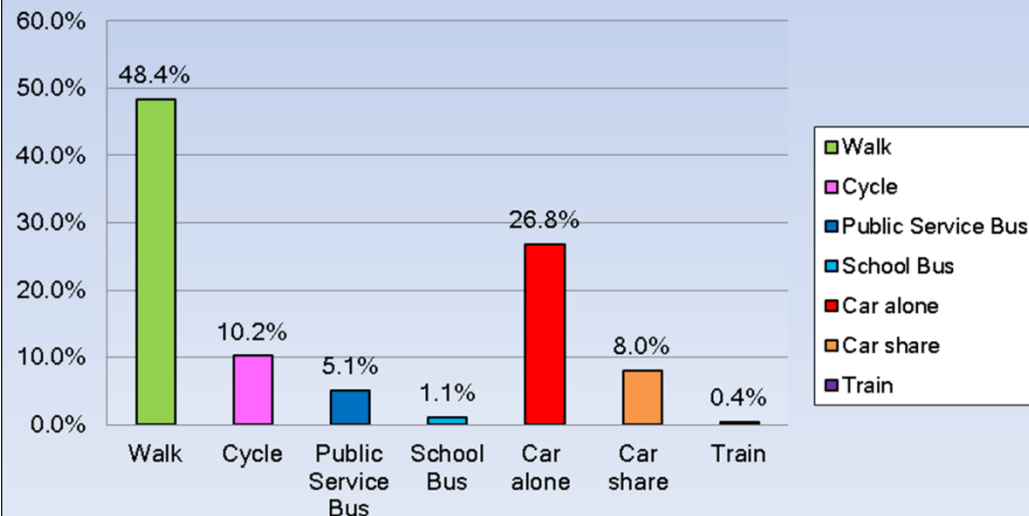

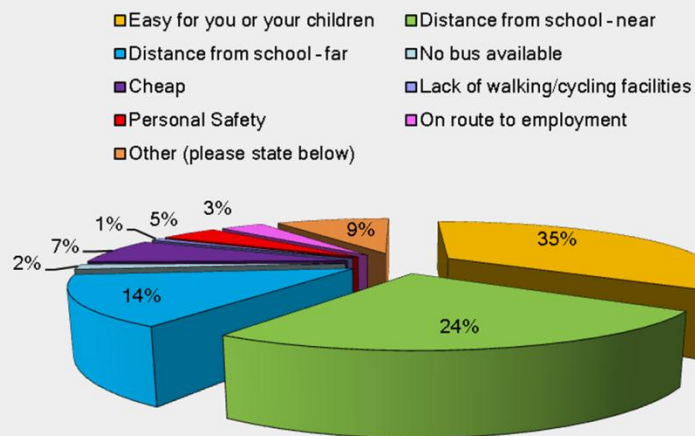

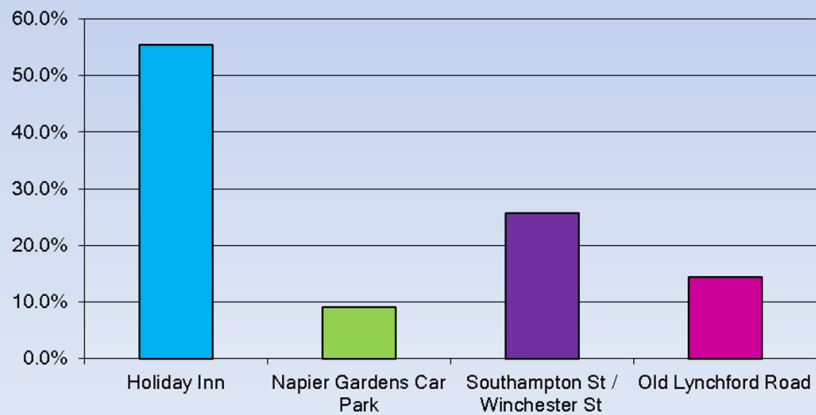

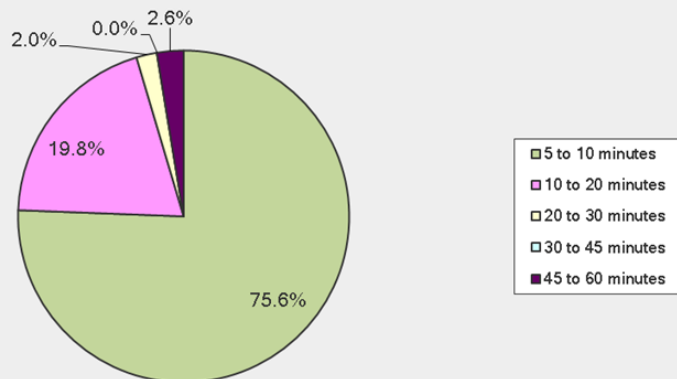

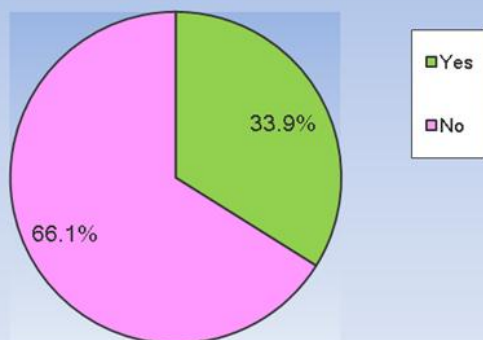

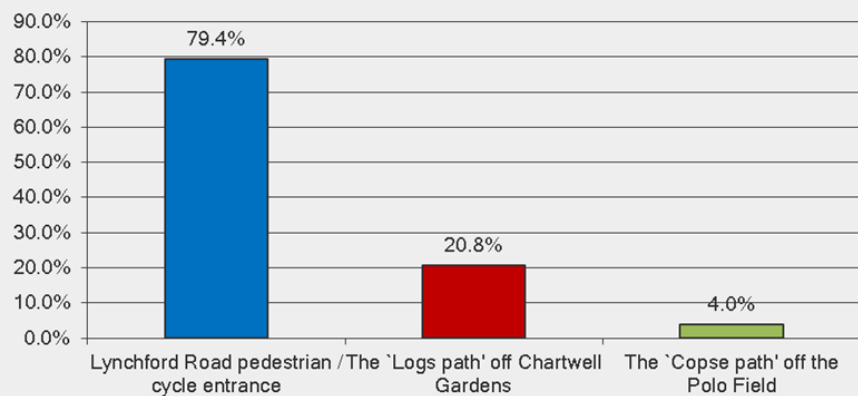

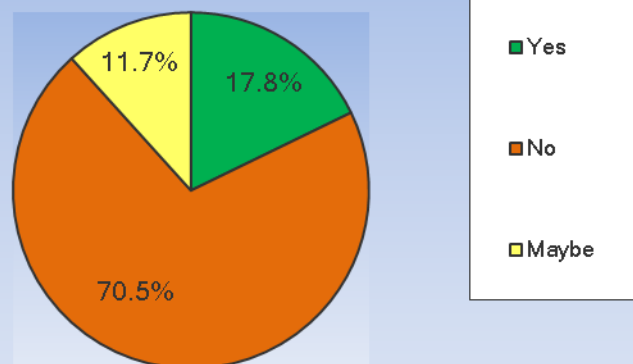
