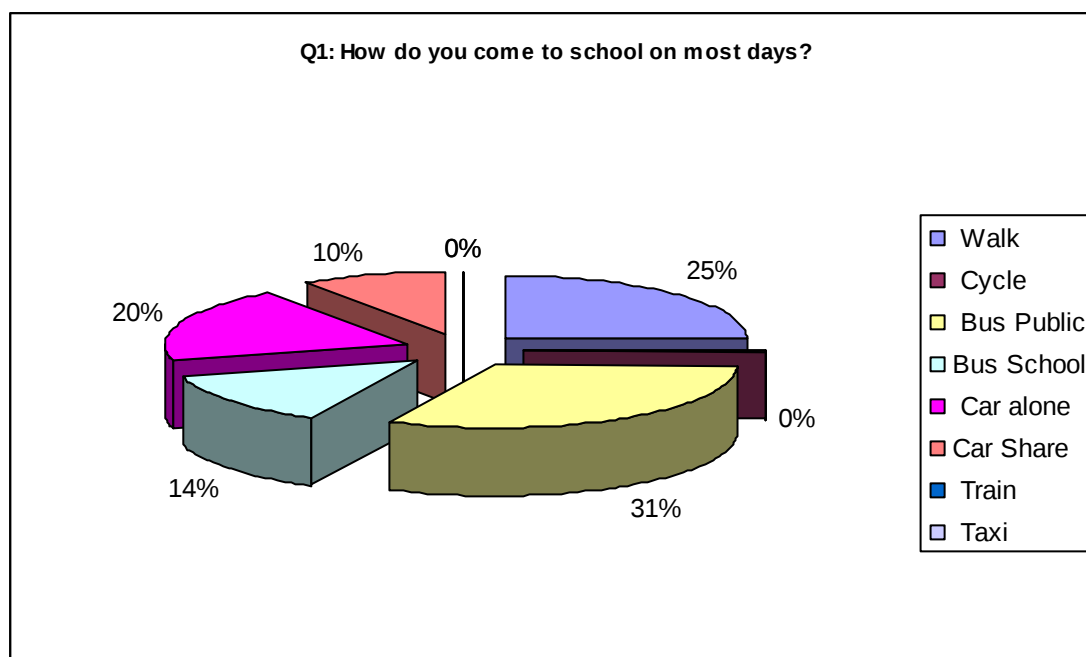


Swanmore College Analysis of School Travel Pupil Survey Results

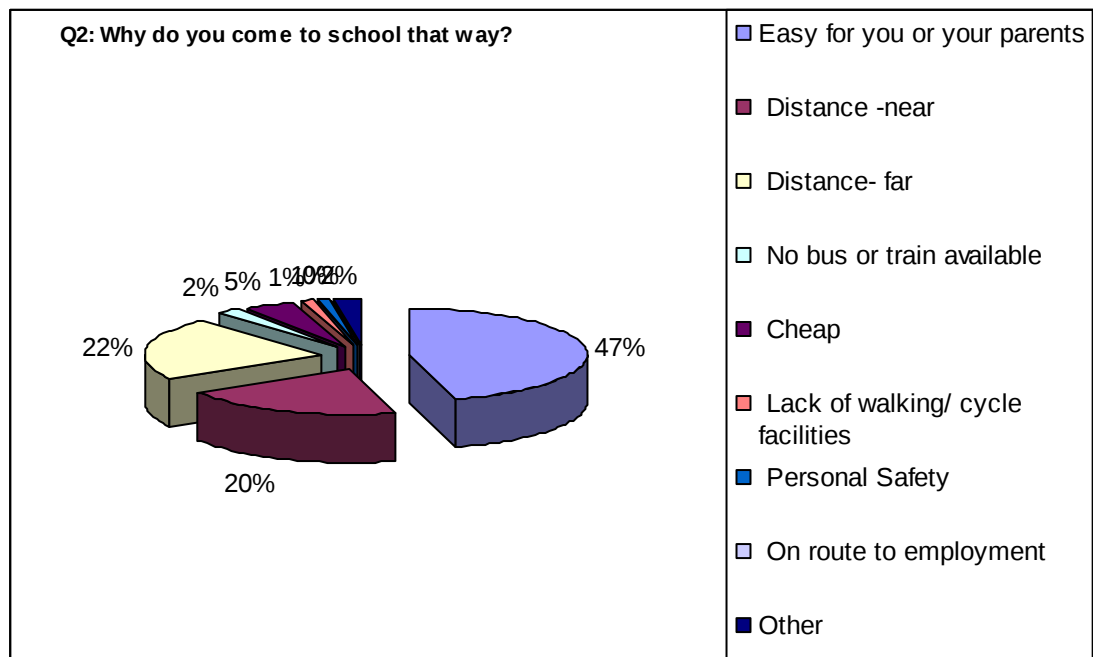

1. How do you come to school on most days?



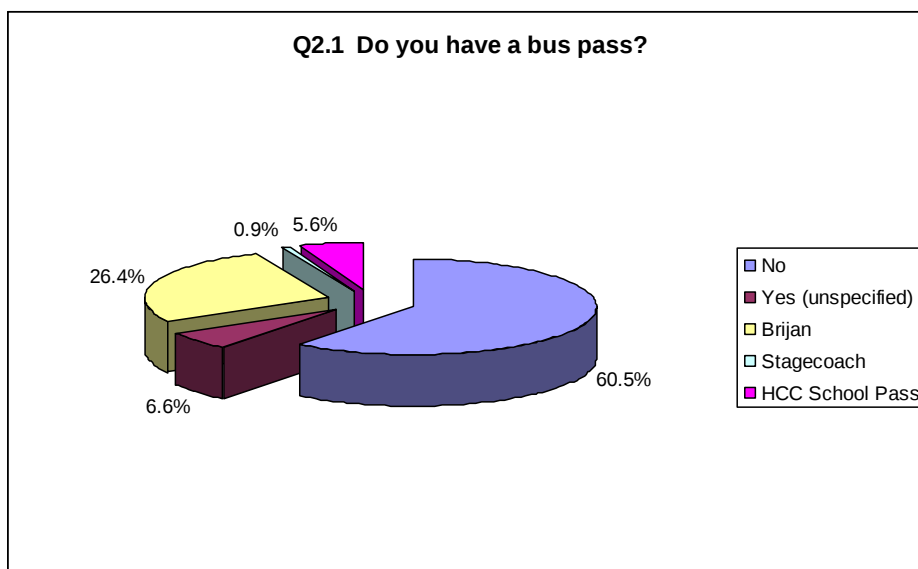

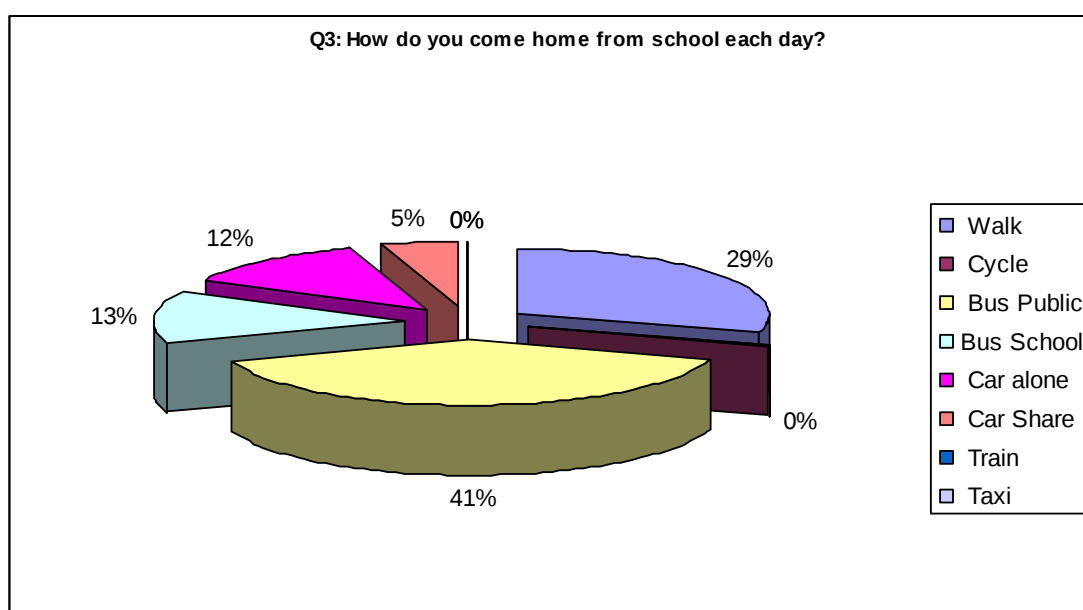

Q2.1 Do you have a bus pass?



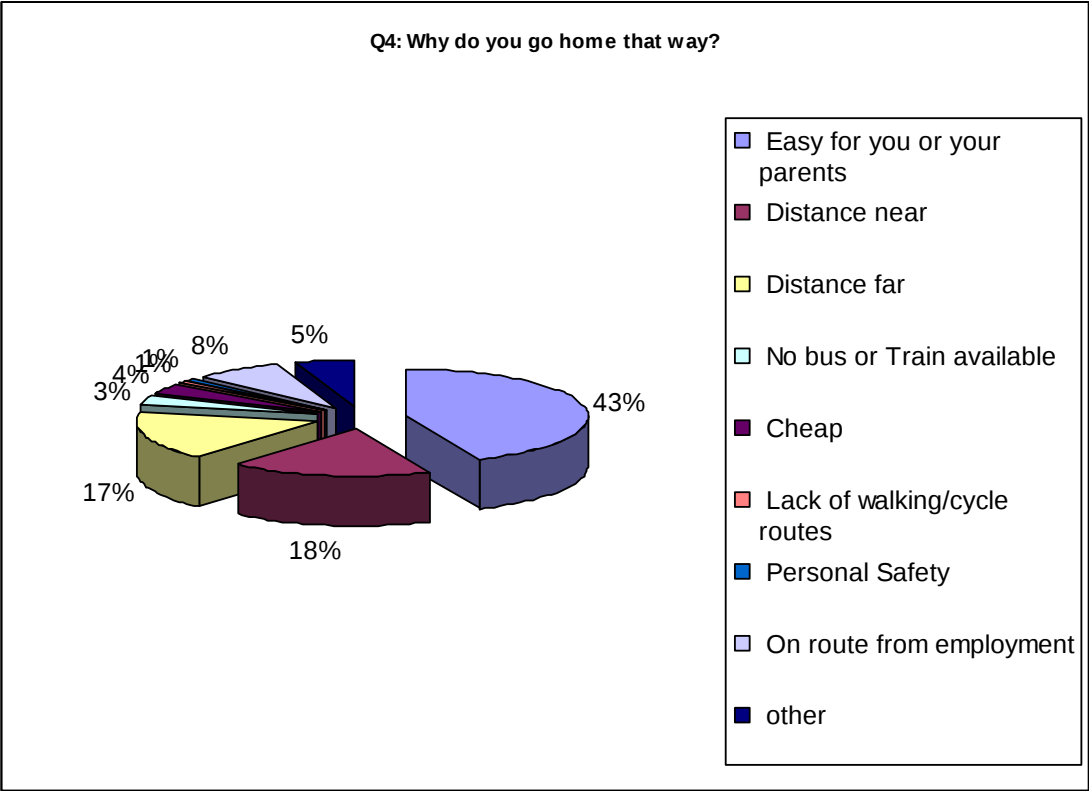

Q3. How do you go home from school each day?



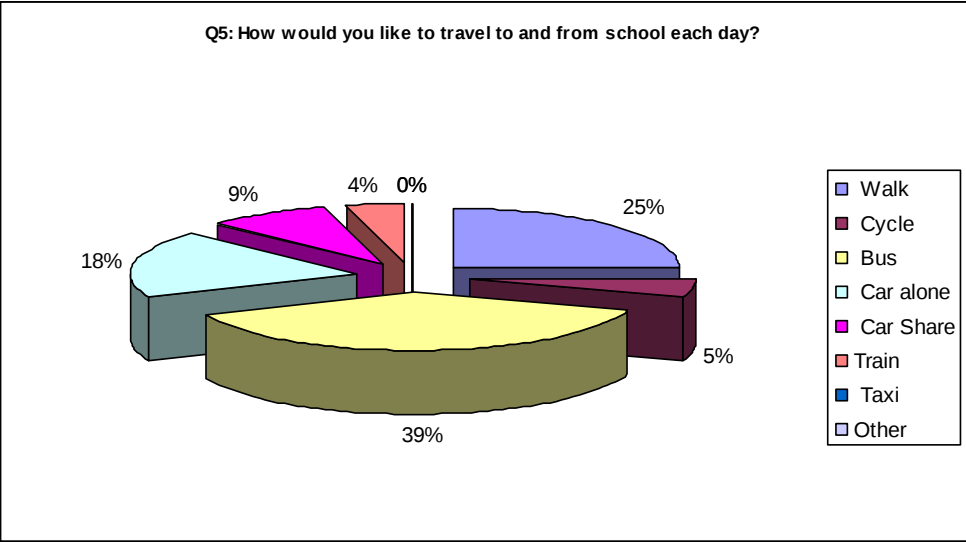

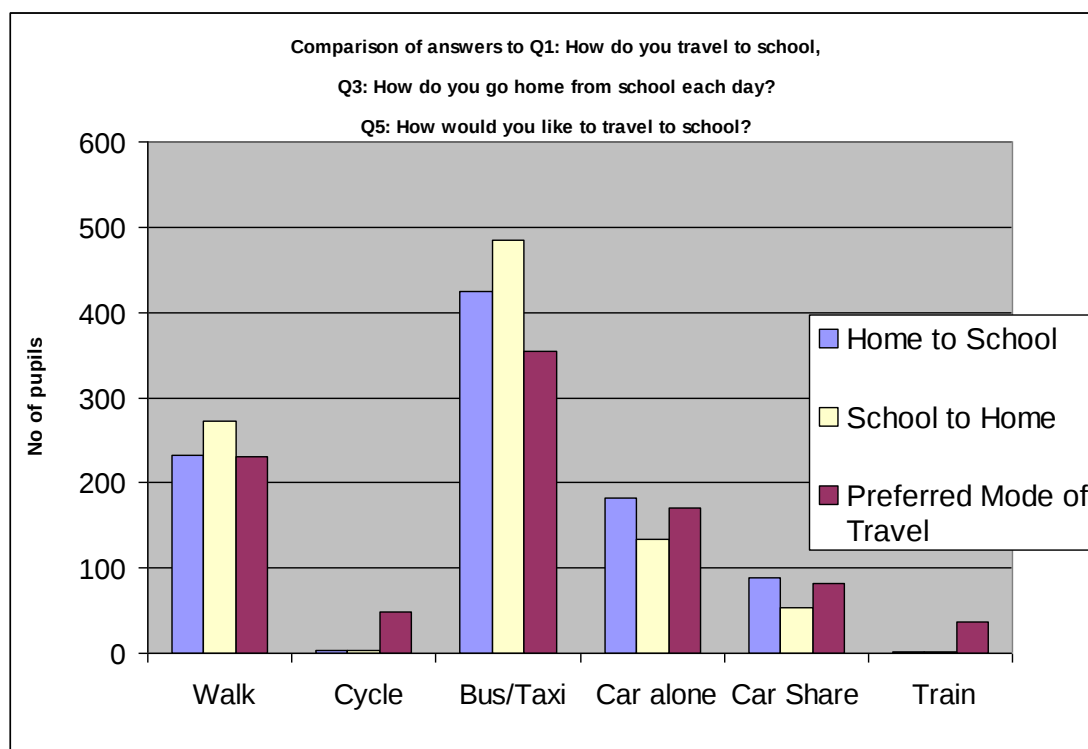

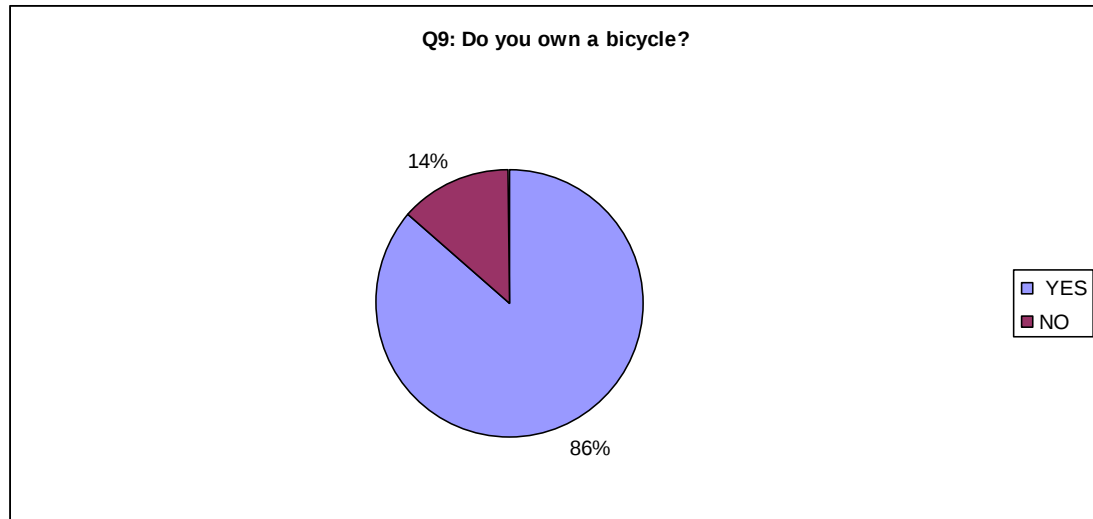

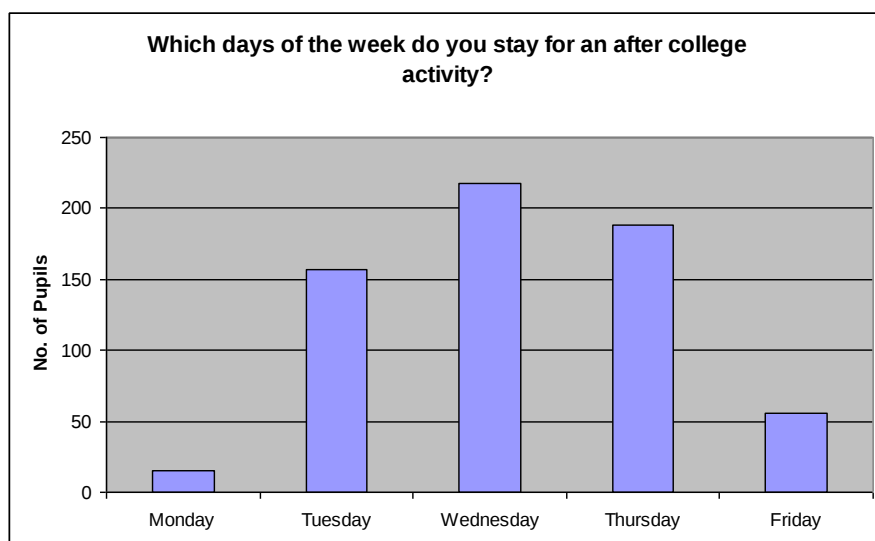

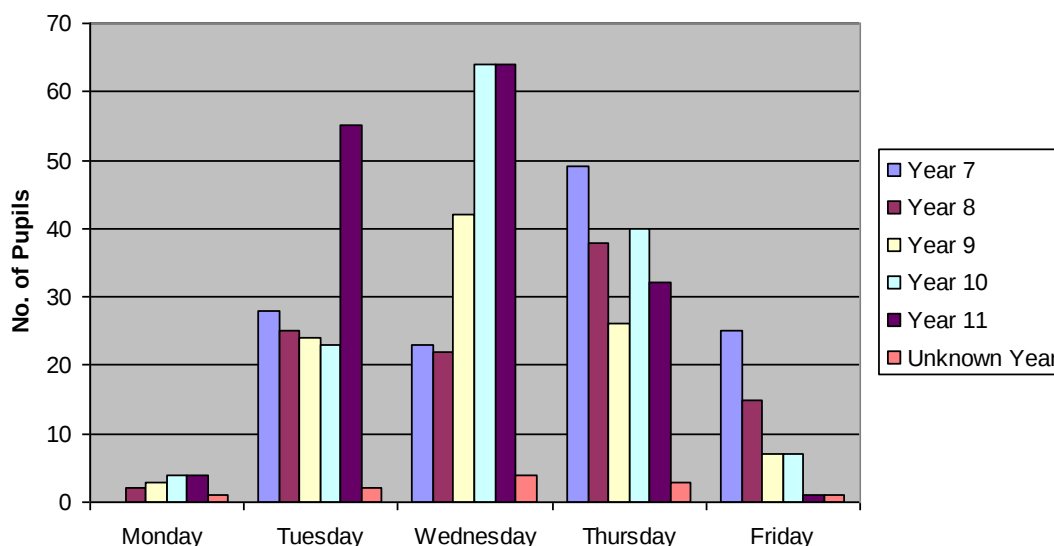
11. Which days of the week do you stay for after college activities?

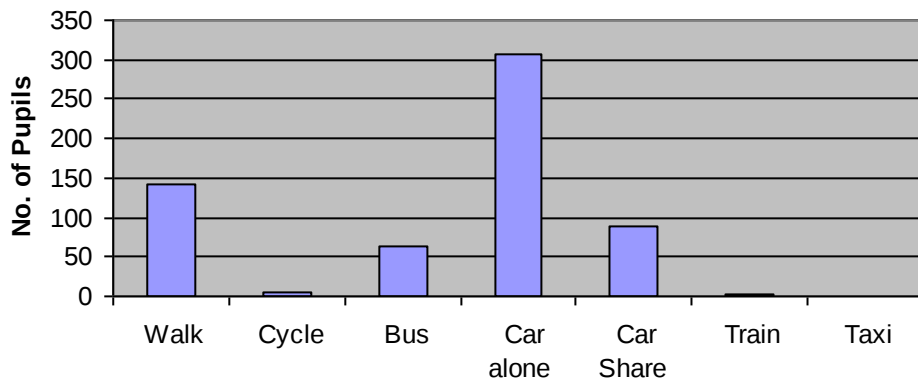

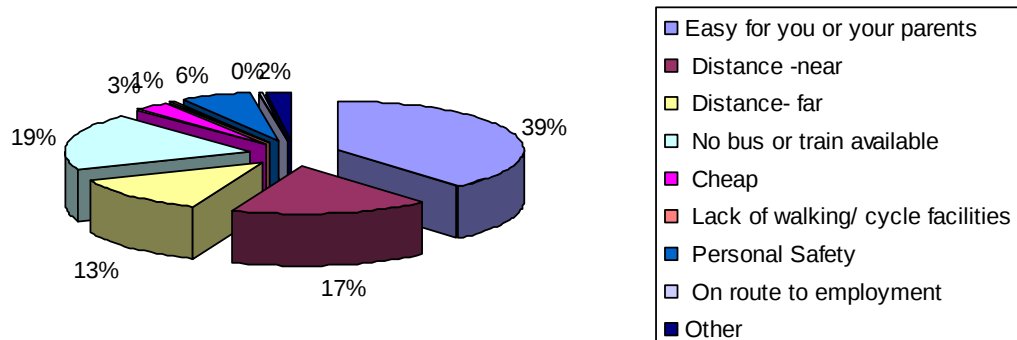

Q13: Why do you go home from an after college activity that way?

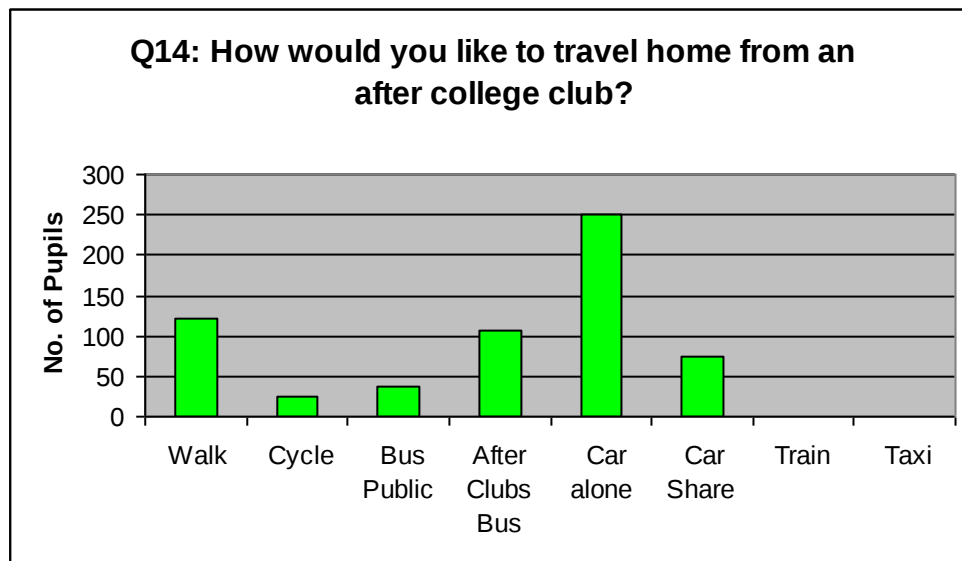

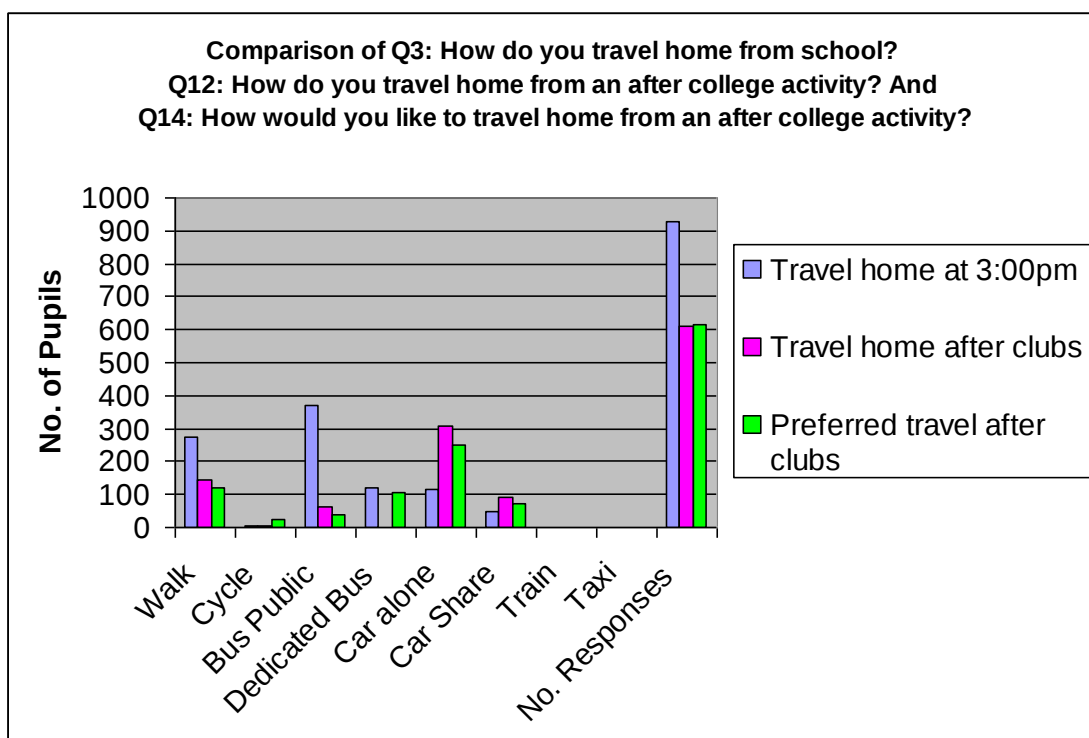

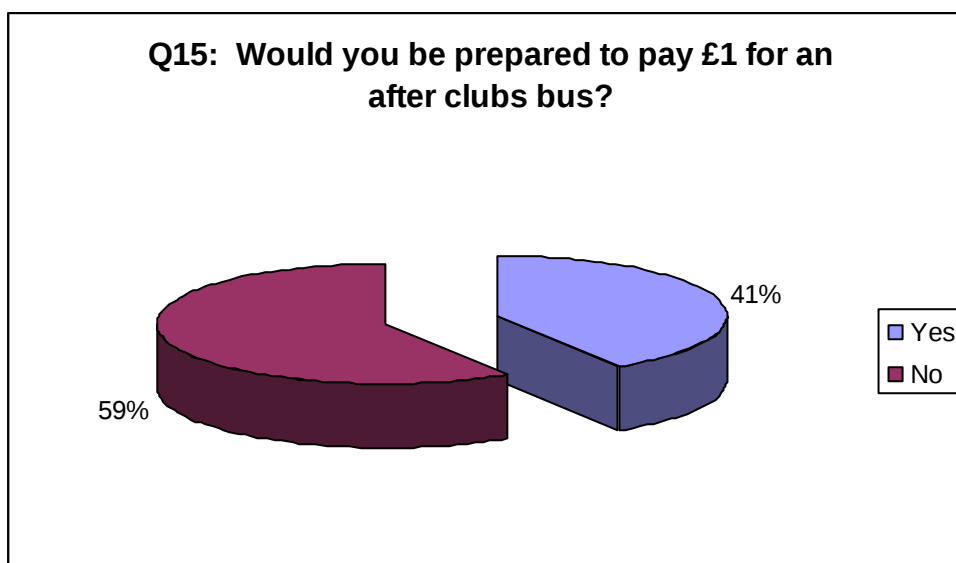

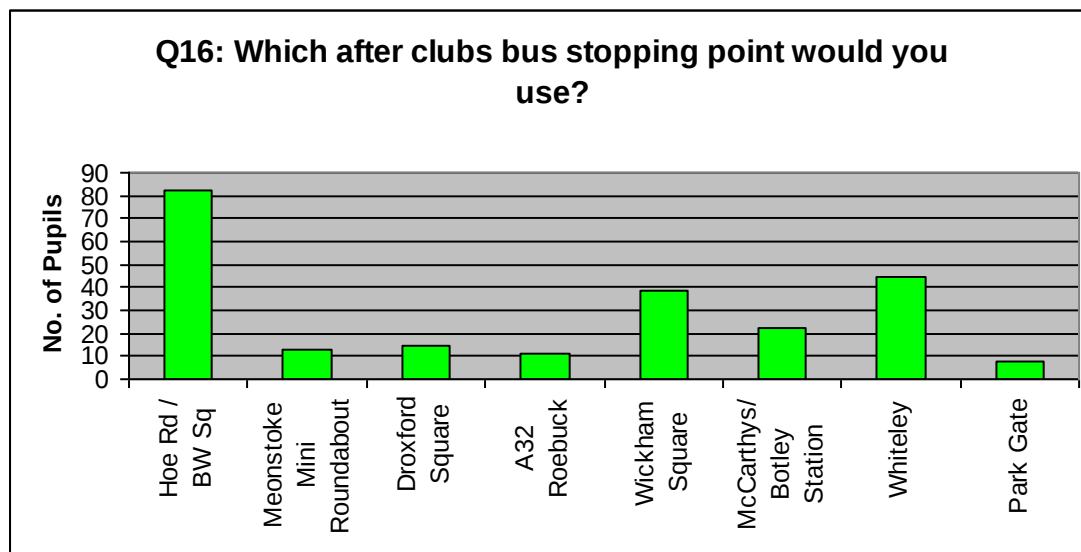
