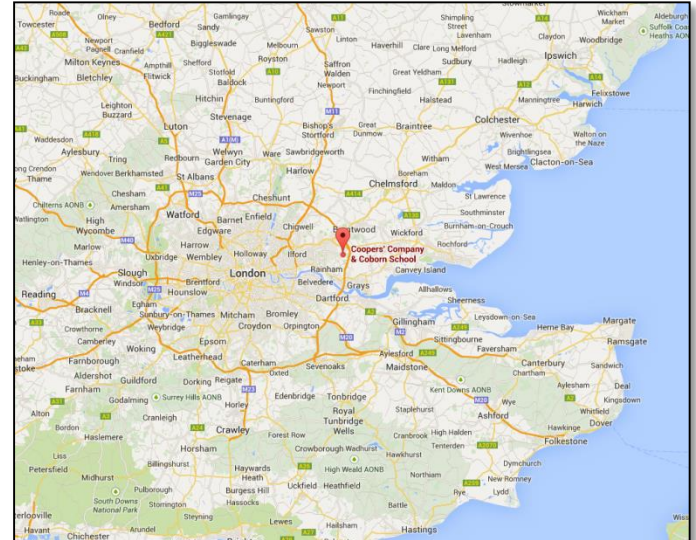

BIKEABILITY

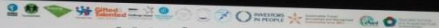
Bikeability participation continues to increase. Since 2009, we have had over 400 students take part in the cycle training held at school and the surrounding roads, which is run during the school day and is available **free** for every student of our school. You don't even need to own your own bike. The school has a selection of BMXs and mountain bikes that students can use and we even supply cycle helmets for them to wear.

Even if students choose not to cycle to school, most children own a bike and will cycle at least a few times a year, so it's important that they have the knowledge and understanding of how to ride a bike safely.
