Hampshire County Council's Travel Planning Team is delivering a Travel Plan for North Whiteley. Our focus is helping you to travel more actively and sustainably by supporting you to swap car journeys for more walking, cycling and shared transport.



£2 single bus fares extended until end of October!

Fares will then be capped at £2.50 until November 2024, helping more passengers get out and about for less.

It's a perfect opportunity to try the 28/28A FIRST bus service that recently extended into North Whiteley. Where will you go on the bus.... ?

All the way to Fareham, hop off the bus at Botley or Swanwick stations for a day out by train. You could change at Park Gate for the X4 / X5 for quicker buses towards Southampton or Portsmouth. Visit Firstbus.co.uk for 28/28A timetable and directions.
