“Scooting to school on my micro scooter and stopping to play on the ‘monkey swingers tree’.”

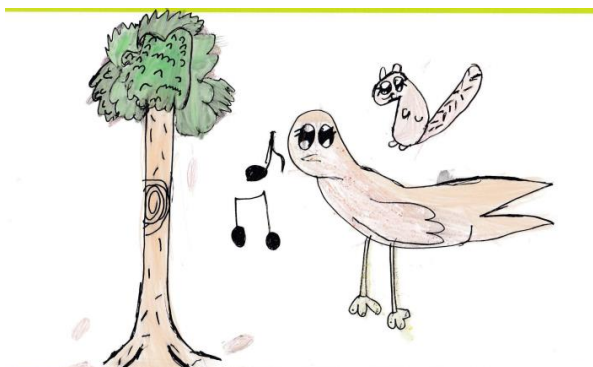
