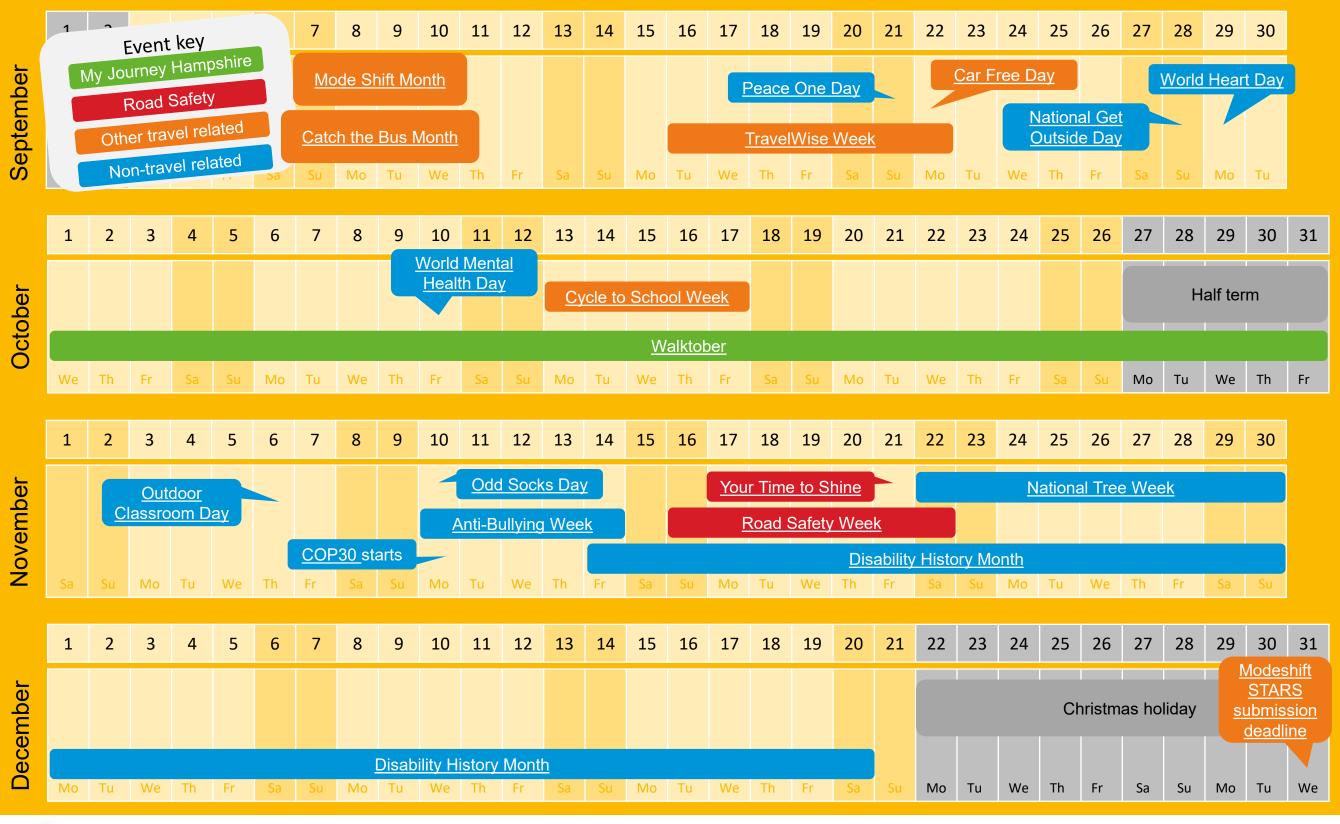

My Journey Primary School STARS Planner – Autumn 2025

September

Mode Shift Month (CU10-12) – <u>Register</u> for Modeshift's month-long celebration dedicated to sustainable travel. Visit <u>Mode Shift Month</u> to download resources for a pupil Travel Trail.

Catch the Bus Month (PT2, PT3, PT6, PT9) – Use the <u>partner pack</u> for ideas and resources to get young people excited about the bus.

TravelWise Week (W16, C16, PT6) – Encourage staff to make an active travel pledge, a great way to start the school year!

Peace One Day – (AQ10, CU3) Use the educational resources on <u>Climate Action</u> and <u>Sustainability</u>.

Car Free Day (AQ2) – Challenge your school community to go 'car-free' for the day and share their 'car-free' experiences.

National Get Outside Day – (PR1) Feature your staff and pupil's favourite local walking, wheeling and cycle routes in your newsletter.

World Heart Day (W11) – Create a <u>heart shaped walk, wheel or cycle</u> near your school or around your school grounds.

October

World Mental Health Day (CU2) – A great opportunity to remind your school community about the importance of daily activity on our mental wellbeing. You could sign up to Hello Yellow – wear yellow to be bright and be seen and raise money!

Walktober (W7) – Sign up for My Journey's Walktober and get moving for our wellbeing, our community and our planet. You could also win a fantastic prize in the Walktober competitions.

Cycle to School Week (C20) – Make a school <u>pledge to pedal</u> and receive a free Pledge Pack full of promotional and curriculum resources.

November

Outdoor Classroom Day (R4, R5) – Get outside for some practical road safety training. Practice <u>pedestrian skills</u> and <u>scooter skills</u>.

COP30 (AQ10, CU3) – Create a campaign to focus on the actions everyone can take to help slow down climate change.

Anti-Bullying Week and Odd Socks Day (PT10) – An opportunity to review the school's behaviour policy to include school and public transport.

Road Safety Week and Your Time to Shine (R10, R18) – Plan road safety activities including Be Bright Be Seen by registering for <u>Your Time to Shine</u>.

National Tree Week (AQ10) – Plant trees to support the local environment and help improve air quality.

Disability History Month (W16-18, C16-18, R19, P3) – With a group of pupils, use the <u>Accessibility Audit Quick Guide</u> to assess the local active travel infrastructure.

December

Christmas Cycling (C16-18)
