

What is the Bordon Town 28 Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel between:

- Bordon Forest Centre
- Hogmoor Caravan Site
- Chalet Hill Shops
- Whitehill Park
- Bordon Post Office
- Blackmoor nr Everley Farm
- Lindford Royal Exchange
- Whitehill
- Bordon Tesco

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2026, the service will cost £1.50* for each single journey.

Children under 5 travel free.

*Prices valid as of April 2026, subject to change.

Accessibility

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

How do I use it?

To use the service you must book your seat by 4pm the day before you wish to travel.

You can book as far in advance as you like.
