3. Submit your claim with photos or copies of your proof of purchase and proof of address

You will be reimbursed within 15 working days of receiving your claim.

Important things to note

1. This offer is only for residents of the North Whiteley development. If you do not live in the North Whiteley development you will not be able to apply.
2. Items must help you to travel sustainably and help reduce your car use.
If in doubt please seek advice from the team by emailing **travelplans@hants.gov.uk** or calling **01962 845638** (weekdays, 9am to 5pm). You can also contact us to check if you are eligible to claim the £100 incentive.
3. The claimant must be aged 18 years or older.
4. Only one claim per household will be accepted. The £100 can be shared between people in the same household.
For example: Two people in the same household can both claim for the purchase of shorter-term bus season tickets, if they are submitted in one claim for the household.
5. The total claim must not exceed £100. You can purchase items that cost more than £100 but will only be reimbursed up to £100.
6. If you are claiming for more than one item you must submit all receipts at the same time.
For example, you could claim for a £50 purchase at a cycle shop, £30 for a railcard and £20 for a bus season ticket = £100 in total, if the claim is submitted at the same time.
7. You must include proof of purchase with your claim, which can be a photo, screenshot or a photocopy of your receipt. We do not need to see the original receipt.
8. You must include proof of address which must include the claimant's name and full address. Suitable documents include a utility bill or council tax statement. Please send a photo, screenshot or photocopy of the document. We do not need to see the original document.
9. Claims must be received by us by end of June 2028. Any claims received after this date will not be processed.

Before you make your claim, check that you have all the evidence you need, for example photos, screenshots or photocopies of your proof of purchase and address. When you are ready to make a claim you can:

Privacy notice

Hampshire County Council is collecting information about you to deliver a Travel Plan, **funded by and** on behalf of the North Whiteley Consortium. We will use the information for the following purposes:

- To enable us to provide the £100 Green Travel Boost (limited to one per household) to the North Whiteley development residents.
- To record that your household has received a £100 Green Travel Boost for monitoring purposes.

The legal basis for the use of your information is UK GDPR Article 6 Para 1(e) 'performance of a task carried out in the public interest in the exercise of official authority vested in the County Council' on behalf of a third party (the North Whiteley Consortium). All data will remain within the UK/EEA (European Economic Area) and will only be shared with third parties where they are undertaking data processing on behalf of Hampshire County Council. We will keep your personal information securely for seven years, after which time it will be destroyed.
