If you are a family living in the North Whiteley Development and are looking to gain your confidence in cycling in and around the area this summer, then Hampshire County Council's Outdoors Team is running free led cycle ride sessions (funded by the North Whiteley Consortium) from Barn Farm Community Centre on Thursday 20 August 2026.

There will be two sessions, the morning session runs from 9am until 12pm and the afternoon session runs from 1pm until 4pm.

Sessions include:

- A bike check and an assessment of the level of ability of each cyclist,
- A led cycle ride to destinations of your choice within the development, e.g. local school or shops.
